

## Sample Script for JARS Net Control Operator

### OPENING STATEMENT SAMPLE:

“Good evening and welcome to this week’s edition of the Saturday Night JARS Net. This is \_\_\_\_\_  
(call sign) my name is \_\_\_\_\_ (First Name), and I will be your net control for this evening’s net.”

“This net is sponsored by the Jacksonville Amateur Radio Society for the purpose of sharing amateur radio related information about events in the club, the community and the surrounding area.”

“This net is transmitted on the K9JX repeater located on top of Beecher High Rise Apartments in Jacksonville Illinois. The K9JX repeater transmits on a frequency of 146.775 MHz with a negative offset of 600 KHz resulting in an input frequency of 146.175 MHz with a PL tone of 103.5 Hz.”

“This net is an open to all amateurs radio operators licensed to operate on the 2-meter band. All traffic must be routed through this net control station. When checking in, please provide your call sign, first name and weather you are in or out.”

“At this time, is there any Emergency or Priority Traffic, if so, please come now! ... (Pause briefly for Traffic) “If Not, Anyone wishing to check in to the Saturday Night JARS Net, please call \_\_\_\_\_ (call sign) at this time...”

\*Be prepared to accept check-ins at this point.

\*After about 10 to 15 check-ins, pause and acknowledge the stations that you have checked in so far. Check stations off as you acknowledge them, so you don’t acknowledge the same station twice. When acknowledging a station, state their call sign and if they are “In or Out”. This way, if any of your information is incorrect, the station can “re-check” during the next check-in opportunity.

\*About every 10 minutes (or less if you need to) take a standby for more stations wishing to check in. Some stations will not be available at the first check-in.

### STANDBY FOR MORE STATIONS SAMPLE:

### ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Club Activities: Up coming Meetings, Events,

\* Prepare your announcements in advance and have them organized in order of priority.

### STANDBY FOR MORE STATIONS SAMPLE:

“Anyone wishing to check in or recheck to the Saturday Night JARS Net, please call \_\_\_\_\_ (call sign) at this time...”

### Play ARRL News line:

\* Be prepared! If you are playing the ARRL News Line, be sure you have downloaded it in advance and your equipment is ready to play the file. If another member is playing the ARRL News Line for you, make sure they are available to run the news line before the net begins.

### CLOSING STATEMENT SAMPLE:

“...That concludes this week’s Saturday Night JARS Net sponsored by the Jacksonville Amateur Radio Society. Thanks to everyone who checked in this evening, and we hope you will join us again next Saturday at 9 PM on the K9JX repeater. To learn more about the Jacksonville Amateur Radio Society see our website at K9JX.com. On behalf of the Jacksonville Amateur Radio Society, I’d like to thank The Amateur Radio News line, \_\_\_\_\_. Having taken care of all business, this net is secure, this station is secure and the repeater is returned to normal operation. This is \_\_\_\_\_ (call sign).”
